Thank you for your interest in the Cheyenne municipal golf courses and the Airport Golf Club. The following pages will provide all the information needed to help provide an exceptional experience.

An outstanding example of the private and public sectors coming together to serve the community, the City of Cheyenne Community Recreation and Events Department allows by contract for two private entities to provide food and beverage services and professional golf services to both city courses while the City of Cheyenne Golf Division is charged with the upkeep and maintenance of both golf courses and is the final authority in the making of policy and procedures. Proceeds from annual passes, green fees, and golf punch passes are retained by the city and are budgeted for upkeep and maintenance of both courses.

Golf professional services at both courses include, retail golf sales, all aspects of the golf play operations, (tee times, fee collection, speed of play, etc.), tournament scheduling, food and beverage operations at Kingham Prairie View Golf Course, lessons, and driving range operations.

The Airport Golf Club Inc, a non-profit organization established in 1947, leases the clubhouse facility located at the Airport Golf Course to provide food and beverage service as well as other activities for its membership and the golfing public. Due to the rules set in place by the club's liquor license, the Airport Golf Club must be a member's only facility and must charge a membership fee. The \$ 50 per person annual fee helps the club with the day-to-day operations of the Double Eagle Diner and the 19th Hole Lounge, which allows the club to offer greatly reduced pricing for food & beverages. Members enjoy a friendly atmosphere while partaking in delicious meals and beverages.

The Double Eagle Diner is available for private functions at no cost for members except food and beverages. Outside food is NOT allowed to be brought into the dining room or lounge without approval of the Club Manager. All events in the dining room must be approved and a contract signed prior to the event. The Double Eagle Diner has both a full menu and events menu available for dine-in or take-out. Some examples of events are golf tournaments, wedding rehearsal dinners and receptions, memorial services, retirement parties, birthday parties, and Christmas parties.

The 19th Hole Lounge offers a full bar including a six-tap draft beer system, major bottle & can beers, variety of wines, and snacks for the course. Recreational pull tabs, sports pools, and "Queen of Hearts" fundraisers are available in support of the Airport Golf Scholarship Fund for local high school seniors of members.

The club also offers a private room downstairs for other functions, such as bunco, bridge, card games, and meetings. This room is available at no cost to members. Check with the club manager for details.

Social memberships are \$50.00 per person per year and the membership year runs from April 1st (current year) to March 31st (following year). Social memberships are required to take part in any of the club sponsored activities, including the use of the bar or restaurant facilities. As stated above, memberships are **PER PERSON MEMBERSHIPS**, this means that all persons using the facilities must be members.

Rules & Regulations – Airport Golf Club, Inc.

The Airport Golf Club is a membership club that provides for its members the opportunity for:

- food and beverage service at greatly reduced cost compared to other outlets.
- the ability to rent the clubhouse for a variety of functions.
- access to all the club's golf events, such as the Club Championship.
- access for a separate fee to the WSGA GHIN System.
- access to all the club's non-golf events, such as "Queen of Hearts" and Friday Night Dinner Specials.
- access to various entertainment opportunities, such as pull tabs and sports pools.
- members of the club may have guests under the following conditions:
 - Guests may visit the club no more than two times with any member, on the third visit, the guests **MUST** become a member.
 - Guests may use the bar and restaurant facilities while with a member **BUT MAY NOT** play pull tabs or participate in any sports pools or club sponsored events.
 - All green fee players at the Airport Golf Course are considered guests of the club for the day of play and are subject to all guest restrictions. Golf Annual Pass holders are not green fee players and therefore not considered guests of the club.

Rules & Regulations

Airport & Prairie View Golf Courses

General Regulations

- **All persons use these facilities at their own risk. The City of Cheyenne, Airport Golf Club, and L & L Incorporated are NOT liable for any injuries or damages caused by golfer activity or natural causes such as lightning, hail, wind, etc. In the event of lightning in the area, the golf shop will make every effort to inform players using a blow horn. However, players assume responsibility for their own safety.**
- To keep the speed of play, all players must have a set of clubs and a bag. Groups are expected to play 9 holes in 2 hours 15 minutes, 18 holes in 4 hours 30 minutes or less.
- Children playing golf under the age of eight must be accompanied by an adult. Children under the age of eight not playing golf will not be allowed on the course.
- Proper conduct consistent with the game of golf is required. Proper attire is encouraged. No Pets are allowed on the course.
- No one under the age of 19 will be allowed to rent or operate a golf cart. Persons who rent golf carts will be responsible for all damages incurred while the cart is rented.
- Golf shop staff will always control all play. Only foursomes are allowed unless approved by the golf shop.
- **Punch cards are required to be presented before play.**
- Outside food and beverage are NOT allowed, we will be happy to serve you in the clubhouse or from the beverage cart.

Tee Time Regulations

- **Golf shop staff will always have control of the tee sheet and will put players and groups together as necessary.**
- Tee times may be made seven (7) days in advance in person, by phone, or online at airportgolfclub.com. Tee times online will begin at 6:30 am each day. Phone and walk-in reservations can be made when the golf shop is open. Only one tee time per person is allowed.
- **No rentals** will be issued 1 and ½ hours prior to published sunset. All rental equipment must be **returned by published sunset.**
- Online tee time privileges will be suspended after three (3) no shows. Any attempt to circumvent the suspension by creating a different online account will result in a loss of online privileges.
- Groups that reserve time and come to the course with less than that number may be grouped with other players and may be subject to a wait longer than their booked tee time.
- Please check in and be ready to play at least 15 minutes before a scheduled tee time.
- **WALK UPS ARE ENCOURAGED.** You may have to wait, but we will get you out.
- **The morning start time and any frost or maintenance delay is determined by the City Golf Manager or representative. The City Golf Manager or representative will let the golf shop know when play will begin on any given day at both courses.**

A Few Words on Maintenance

Players must be aware of the need to carry out necessary maintenance practices which may interfere temporarily with play.

Practices such as mowing, irrigation, fertilization, aeration, and topdressing are critical in creating the surfaces on which the game is played. For the safety of all, players are required to always yield to the maintenance staff, but especially during the early morning hours while the course is being prepared for daily play.

Failure to yield to the maintenance staff will result in the loss of playing privileges for that day. Patience and courtesy towards golf course personnel is required and greatly appreciated when maintenance practices are encountered.

***Notes on passes.**

All passes are good for BOTH courses, punch passes are 9 hole rounds so they are punched twice for 18 holes, punch passes DO NOT expire till punched out. A social membership must be purchased to keep a handicap.
