Ages:

Open to all children ages 8 to 18. **Children MUST be eight at the time of registration or turn eight during or after the dates of the program.**

Schedule of Instruction -

8:00 to 8:45 AM
9:00 to 9:45 AM
10:00 to 10:45 AM

Each student will receive 45 minutes of instruction at the time that is chosen by the parent. Students will then be broken up into age groups within the time slot chosen. The age groups are 8-9, 10-11, 12-13, and 14 to 18. There will be no golf component this year.

Types of Instruction –

The goal of the program is to provide all students with the basic knowledge of the golf swing, proper golf etiquette, and basic rules. Students will have the skills to play and the knowledge to be able to act accordingly when on the course. This program is not designed for individual instruction but rather the basics of golf in the group setting but we will do our best to give as much individual attention as possible.

Bad Weather –

We will do our best to get the word out when the weather forces a cancellation of a lesson day. We will make every effort to decide before 7:00 AM but will make a definite decision by 7:30 AM. Please listen to AM 1240 KFBC or FM 104.9 KRRR for cancellation information. If during the lesson day the weather becomes bad, we will discontinue the lessons, and again announce cancellation on the two above radio stations. Please help us out by keeping an eye to the sky and calling either 638-3700 or 637-6420 for information. **There will be no make-ups or refunds because of bad weather.** The schedule is so tight that makeups are not possible.

Pick Up Times –

Please pick up your students at the time their lesson will end. There will be no golf component this year, only the 45-minute instruction period.

Preparation –

Please make sure that your students are prepared to be outside. Sunscreen and mosquito repellent are good ideas. Also, please have them prepared for cold as well as warm weather. Tennis shoes or golf shoes with soft spikes are allowed. Water is the best for replenishing fluids. Prairie View has a full-service snack bar that will open at 8:00 AM every Monday for those types of needs.

Conduct –

Conduct that is a safety concern, interferes with the normal course of instruction, or damages the golf course or grounds will not be tolerated. All offenses will be handled by calling the parents to pick up the student and that student not being allowed to participate in the rest of the program for the year and there will be no refund given.

Supervision –

All students will be supervised always during the junior golf day. We will do everything necessary to ensure the safety of all students in the program.
